Abstracts should be limited to one page only, should clearly state the proposed paper title and should include a very brief description of the paper.

On the subject line of the email please indicate MSTS Abstract - (*Presenting author's or authors' name*) and please also name your attached abstract file as MSTS Abstract - (*Presenting author's or authors' name*).doc or *.pdf.
